# Certified Peer Specialist

**A certified peer specialist is someone who has lived experience with mental illness and/or substance use disorder, and has formal training to support recovery.**

 An active participant on the consumer's treatment and recovery team.

 A paid professional who uses their experience and training to support recovery.

You must complete an application and pass an interview to be selected for training. Only the first 50 applications will be considered.
