**A certified peer specialist is someone who has lived experience with mental illness and/or substance use disorder, and has formal training to support recovery.**

 An active participant on the consumer's treatment and recovery team.

 A paid professional who uses their experience and training to support recovery.

**You must complete an application and pass an interview to be selected for training. Only the first 50 applications will be considered.**
