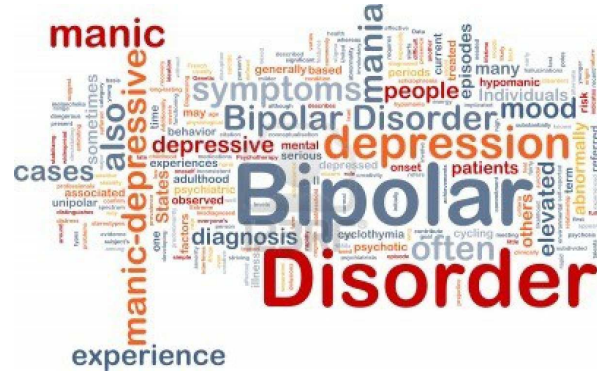


Mental Health America of Wisconsin
