### Our Certified Peer Specialist will:

- Work with adults with mental illness and/or substance use disorders.
- Provide peer support to residents struggling with mental health and/or substance use disorders.
- Assist residents in articulating personal goals for recovery through the use of one-to-one group sessions.
- Support residents in identifying and creating goals and developing recovery plans with the skills, strengths, supports and resources to aid them in achieving those goals.
- Identifies and responds to crisis and/or mental needs of residents and ensures a healthy environment as a mentor.
- Use motivational interviewing skills, WRAP, and personal experiences to develop meaningful relationships.
- Use ongoing group sessions to teach residents how to identify and combat negative self-talk and how to identify and overcome fears by using literature, media, etc. to assist the resident in gaining hope.
- Actively pursue communication with treatment teams regarding resident status.
- Complete documentation within established department standards and regulations.
