



Dear Training Participant,

We at the Wisconsin Peer Specialist Employment Initiative would like to provide an update to those with questions about upcoming trainings amidst the COVID-19 pandemic. This letter includes updates regarding the cancelation of specific Certified Peer Specialist trainings throughout the state.

The Madison training scheduled to start on March 14th, 2020 has been canceled. At this time, we are unsure when or where this may be rescheduled.


The Milwaukee training scheduled to start on March 24th, 2020 has also been canceled. It has tentatively been rescheduled for the following dates: May 26th, 28th, 30th and June 2nd, 4th, 6th. It will still be held a IndependenceFirst in Milwaukee with the same facilitators.

There are no other training cancellations at this time due to COVID-19 concerns; however, we expect there to be further updates in the near future regarding other Certified Peer Specialist trainings in Wisconsin.
