Position Description: This is a peer-to-peer role providing peer support to parents who are participating in the Dunn County Family Treatment Court program and/or have CHIPS orders with Dunn County. Team members will engage in a variety of activities with their participants, which will enable participants to successfully achieve recovery and reunification or stabilization of their family. Work related duties could include:

- Accompanying participants to legal appointments
- Accompanying participants to court-ordered activities
- Connecting participants with the recovery community
- Supporting participants to develop healthy hobbies
- Teaching participants coping and wellness skills
- Teaching participants daily living skills such as budgeting, cooking, organizing, effective parenting, etc.
- Assisting participants to access available resources

Additional position duties include:

- Team members will be assigned to 4-5 families
- Team members will be authorized a certain number of hours to work with each participant, based on their
 needs at that time. It is expected that the number of hours with each participant will be higher in the beginning
 of their involvement with the Family Treatment Court program
- Team members will need to be able to work as part of a team that includes Dunn County social workers, family treatment court coordinators, and other providers
- Team members will be required to complete regular documentation of the services they provide to their participants

- Lived experience of involvement with the child welfare system
 - o If children have been placed out of home, successful reunification lasting at least 1 year
- Lived experience with treatment court
- Lived experience with substance use challenges
- Already are or able to become a Certified Peer Specialist (https://www.wicps.org/certified-peer-specialist/)
- Ability to work remotely and be self-directed
- Fluent in or able to learn Microsoft Word, Excel, and internet/email use
